- An official acceptance letter into a POST Certified peace officer training academy, or confirmation of enrollment, if applicable
- Two (2) letters of recommendation Letters should highlight the applicant's academic or personal achievements and potential to make positive contributions to the law enforcement profession.
- Applicant's resume. Resume should include: education, employment history, involvement in their community, extracurricular activities, leadership roles, and honors received.
